

Persevering in What Is Right

Justice isn't always easy — sometimes it takes time, effort, patience, and sacrifice.

St. Turibius kept going because he loved God and the people he served. Confirmation strengthens us to keep choosing what is right, even when it becomes difficult, tiring, or inconvenient.
